



Forest School

Wilderness Warriors Forest School will be running on site after-school sessions, providing opportunities for children to explore and play in the great outdoors! This will include learning bush-craft skills such as whittling, using tools and the safe lighting of fires, and how to identify flora and fauna. Your child will carry out natural crafting and gardening activities and develop their understanding of ecosystems. Forest School helps children gain self-confidence, improve their communication skills, and develop a sense of independence, inquisitiveness and the ability to manage risks.

Each session will include a drink and a snack prepared over a fire. Forest School will take place in all weathers and outdoor education kit must be worn for all sessions, including waterproofs, (both jackets and trousers/dungarees are desirable) hats and wellies during wet weather. Please be prepared that your child may return home muddy!

Sessions will run in half-term blocks, with payment to be made in advance.

Sessions start the week commencing 13/01/20 and the half-term is 5 weeks:

Monday 3-5pm yrs 1 - 6 £6 per session x5= £30.00

If you would like your child to take part in Forest School please complete the form and return to the school office ASAP, places will be allocated on a first come-first serve basis. If your child is allocated a place, you will then be required to make payment for the half term prior to the sessions starting, (cash, or cheques made payable to Lisa Jackson).
