Dear Parent/Carer

On Monday 9 May Draconis Class will be spending the day at Station Farm in Westhay on a Forest School trip. This will take place during the normal school day with the children returning to school for 3pm.

We ask that the children come to school in their outdoor education clothes, appropriate to the weather, and very importantly (whatever the weather) long sleeved and legged clothing is essential to prevent ticks and Lyme disease. Suitable footwear - sturdy boots or wellies – they will get wet and possibly very dirty. In case of wet weather, please ensure that coats have a hood. We will be able to provide waterproof trousers. In case of hot weather, lightweight long sleeved clothing can be worn.

In addition to this, your child will also need to bring a packed lunch and plenty to drink. If children would like their sandwiches toasted on the fire then please wrap them in foil with their names clearly marked with pen!  
*NB. Children who have already paid for a lunch on this day, or who receive a free school meal, will be provided with a packed lunch **but will need to provide their own drink.***

A voluntary contribution of £5.00 will be required from each child to cover the cost of transport there and back.
